10 Weeks

The 10-week programme is the most immersive Expedition. You will take part in all three phases.

7 Weeks

If you don't have as much time, the 7week programme is a great option. You can take part in two of the phases.

5 Weeks

Our 5-week programme will give you the chance to engage in one meaningful project and a shorter adventure phase.

HOW DOES EXPEDITION WORK?

On every Expedition, you will have the chance to take part in three different phases. The three phases are Community project, Environment project and Adventure Challenge.

- You will be in project groups of 12-14 Venturers and supported by staff and Venturer Managers.
- Teams change between each project, so you'll get a chance to work with lots of different people.
- When you aren't out 'on phase', you'll be at the Raleigh Fieldbase with the full Expedition team.
- Once you've completed your Expedition, you will join an amazing global community of inspiring and motivated Raleigh Venturers.





COMMUNITY PHASE

Find out more

Imagine a world where everyone has access to education and community facilities, so that they can build the skills they need to prosper in future life. Where everyone, no matter their background or where they live, have access to learning. Play your part in making this a reality.

Through community-led initiatives we aim to establish what works for the communities we work in. All projects are needed, impactful and make a long-term sustainable impact.

- In South Africa support construction of school and educational facilities, such as playground jungle gyms and school community gardens.
- In Costa Rica support the building of classroom and school facilities in indigenous communities, working with local authorities to meet the need.
- In Borneo work alongside local indigenous people to construct key facilities for, such as a village hall, toilet block or drainage systems.

ADVENTURE LEADERSHIP PHASE

The Adventure Challenge phase may take teams on challenging treks through rainforest, volcanic, jungle or mountain landscapes on a variety of stunning routes that tourists often don't get access to.

This will be an experience that brings you together with other Venturers, and one you'll never forget.

- Challenge yourself, develop your leadership skills and learn about the power of team effort.
- Build core skills, resilience and determination to drive change.
- Wild camp and sleep under the stars or set up camp in community buildings and schools.
- Learn survival, camp craft and map reading skills; navigate your group through incredible landscapes.
- Go back to basics and become selfsufficient while living in beautiful settings.

Experience stunning landscapes

ENVIRONMENTAL PHASE



Our natural world is under threat, from climate change and human interaction. Our projects support environmental conservation efforts to protect natural landscapes and precious wildlife.

You will take an active role in protecting natural resources and vulnerable environments.

- In South Africa protect local wildlife in the Kruger area. Work may involve: alien plant removal, indigenous tree planting, snare sweep clearing and road clearing.
- In Costa Rica support conservation work in national parks by contributing to the work of park rangers and local environment experts.
- In Borneo take action to protect some of Southeast Asia's most precious natural landscapes through mangrove rehabilitation and reforestation activities.

TIANA'S STORY

"For my environmental phase we worked on fence line removal and erosion control work. We also helped remove snares that pose a threat to the animals. Removing fences actually allow the animals to have a bigger living area so they can walk freely and safely, it's so they won't get trapped and get caught on metal. I have learnt so much from our guide, gaining knowledge on things like tracking, identifying different animals and footprints."



- Work alongside local people to improve their access to education on the indigenous community project.
- Work with rangers to help conserve Costa Rica's biodiversity and improve access to national parks on the Environmental project.
- Trek through rainforest and up volcanoes on a variety of stunning routes that tourists don't get access to.
- Experience the life of Pura Vida living off the beaten track.

DID YOU KNOW?

Costa Rica is leading the international fight against climate change.

Despite making up only 0.03% of the world's landmass, Costa Rica is home to nearly 5% of the planet's biodiversity.



Learn navigation and map reading skills!



Work together on construction projects



Home to some of the world's most unique wildlife, on Expedition in Borneo you will embrace jungle life while volunteering to support indigenous communities and the growth of rainforest landscapes.

What will I be doing?

- Work in an indigenous Dusun community, supporting construction of important facilities such as toilets, community halls or drainage systems.
- Work with local experts to rehabilitate precious mangroves, helping to support nature and tackle environmental degradation.
- Trek across the Salt Trail of the Crocker Range on your trek and support an eco project during your Jungle Adventure.

DID YOU KNOW?

At 140 million years old, the Borneo rainforest is one of the oldest in the world and the largest in Southeast Asia.

Malaysian Borneo is home to over 100 endemic species, including the Probiscus Monkeys, Sunda Leopard and Pygmy Elephant.

LIFE ON RALEIGH EXPEDITION

"You think not having things like WiFi or TV will bug you, but it makes you really appreciate what you have and the people you care about."

You will immerse yourself into new cultures and landscapes on Expedition. Whether in a rural community, camping or at Fieldbase, this will be true Expedition living.

Food

You will get to try local foods and will at times be cooking for yourself from 'Raleigh rations' while on project.



Accomodation

You will be staying in different places for each phase of your Expedition, this will be in a tent while on project and in bunk beds at Fieldbase. Facilities will be basic - expect cold showers. Conditions will be more basic than you are used to, but it will soon become normal. Don't expect tourist hotspots, five-star hotels and 24/7 WIFI. Instead expect a memorymaking adventure full of fun and rewarding experiences.

Camp life

Expect to sit around the fire, tell stories, play cards and gaze at the stars. Everyone will have responsibilities around camp, such as collecting water for the showers, collecting firewood and clearing the area to discourage wildlife.

Our no phones and no alcohol policy means that team bonding and connecting with fellow Venturers is a priority.





Safety is at the heart of everything.

This starts with selecting the appropriate places to volunteer, all the way to providing comprehensive safety training to all Venturers. Our Safety Management Systems are robust, practical, and effective.

- All teams are supported by experienced operations staff 24/7, trained in incident management
- All project sites are risk assessed and have robust emergency incident plans in place
- In the event of emergency, professional and skilled operators such as medical air rescue services and medical practitioners are available as part of our support network.

Experienced in-country staff and Venturer Management team on every Expedition

Our full-time staff in each country are highly experienced, committed and resourceful individuals selected and trained to ensure they uphold our high safety standards.

In addition to our full-time staff, we are supported by a Venturer Manager team who undertake support roles in our office and leading project teams on the ground.

Venturer Managers come from various backgrounds; all have broad basic skills and where necessary, we recruit Venturer Managers with technical or recognised national governing body qualifications such as medics or mountain leaders.
