ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECT:

Caño Negro, in northern Costa Rica, is one of the world's most important wetlands and a Ramsar site. During the rainy season, the Río Frío overflows and transforms the area into a vast lagoon, attracting thousands of migratory birds like storks, spoonbills, and cormorants. It's also home to endangered species such as the jaguar and the gaspar fish, a living fossil that has existed since the age of dinosaurs. Through their collaboration with local communities and conservation organizations, Raleigh volunteers contribute to the protection of biodiversity, sustainable resource management, and the restoration of critical ecosystems.
